- 1. PARTICIPANT/GUARDIAN AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD NORTH TEXAS STATE FAIR ASSOCIATION, INC., hereinafter referred to as "FAIR", THEIR OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, MEMBERS, AND VOLUNTEERS AND/OR AGENTS HARMLESS AGAINST ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, DAMAGES, COSTS AND EXPENSES, including reasonable attorney's fees for the defense thereof, arising from Participants', or his/her guests', or children's activities on or around the North Texas State Fair Association Grounds, hereinafter referred to as "Fair Grounds", at any time, EVEN IF the claim, demand, damage, cost or expense is CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE OF THE FAIR.
- 2. PARTICIPANT/GUARDIAN FURTHER RELEASES THE FAIR FROM ALL LIABILITY. THE FAIR may otherwise owe to Participant, his heirs, survivors, beneficiaries, or assigns FOR ANY PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, that Participant suffers while on the Fair Grounds, at any time, including but not limited to first aid, treatment or service rendered participant during participation in any event and/ or practice. This release applies to all injuries or damages which may be suffered by Participant, his heirs, survivors, beneficiaries, or assigns, EVEN IF CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE OF THE FAIR. This liability release also applies to claims and causes of action for injury to or the death of any of Participant's children.
