



2021 Queen and Princess Candidates

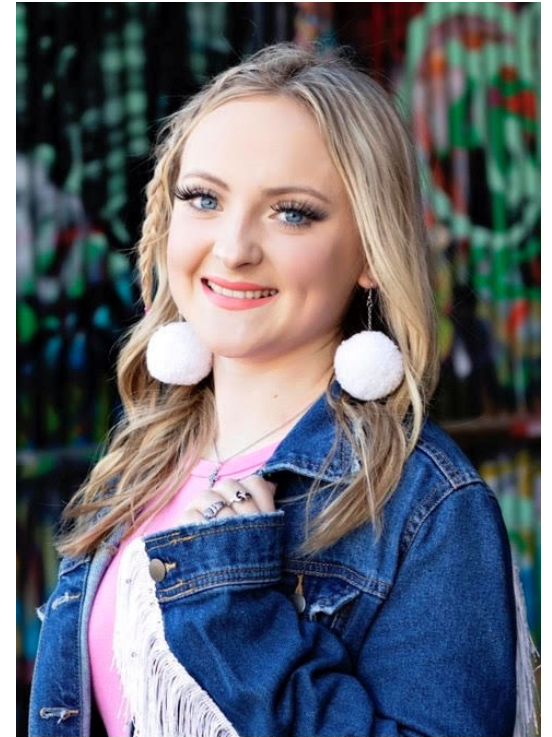
Haleigh Miller, Aubrey FFA Queen Candidate

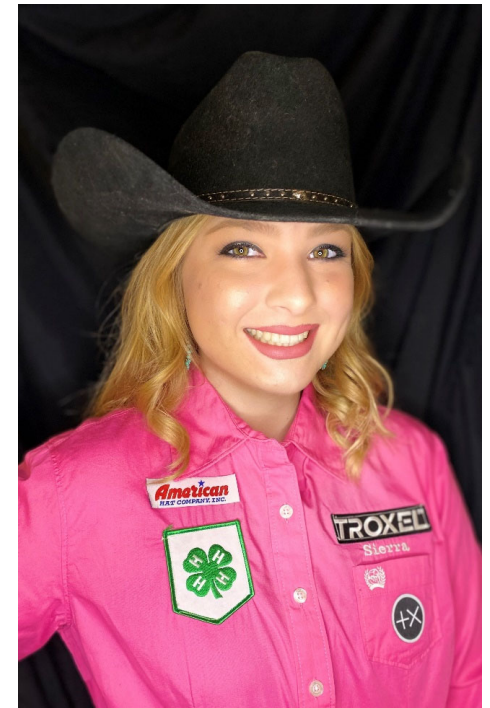
Ava Larson, Silver Saddle 4-H Queen Candidate
